## Texas District UPC RV Owners Association RV Park Policy Crusader Camp, Junior High Camp, and Senior High Camp

(This policy covers the private RV Park only.

All other RV requests are subject to the On-Campus RV Policy)

- The Texas District UPC RV Association Park is **NOT** part of the Camp during Crusader Camp, Junior High Camp and Senior High Camp, however, due to potential risks of unauthorized entry into the Camp, the gate to the RV Association Park driveway is to be kept shut to prevent such entry. All RV Association Members who will be staying in the Park during any of the Camps are asked to register with camp security for the sake of accountability and emergency purposes.
- 2. Anyone who is of proper camp age staying in the RV Association Park desiring to attend the Camp must register as a DAY CAMPER.
  - All Day Campers must comply with the Camp rules and policies.
  - All Day Campers must check in and out at the proper times set by the Camp Director.
  - Upon official check out, all Day Campers will no longer be under the liability aspects of the Camp and must be released to a pre-approved guardian who will be present to sign that camper out.
  - No Day Camper is allowed to be on campus after curfew for any reason.
- 3. All persons staying overnight and/or for the duration of Camp in the above mentioned private RV Park requesting on-campus access for any reason during Camp must submit a Worker's Application with Background Check Consent, complete the Child Abuse Prevention Training and pass the Child Abuse Prevention Test with the grade of 70% or above and are subject to all Camp Policies, Procedures, Schedules and Activities for the duration of the Camp. This includes the check-in and check-out procedures.
  - EXCEPTION: As per the Texas District UPC District Board, "A Licensed Minister and his/her spouse are welcome to visit the Camps. As always, they should register with the camp office upon entering the grounds. Due to the new closed campus structure in which traffic on and off the campus is being reduced, it is asked that visits be limited in number and length of time. Ministers and spouses visiting the camp should not be accompanied by other individuals.
    - i. Ministers' children who are under the designated camp age are permitted with their parents.
    - ii. Ministers' children who are of the designated camp age should be registered campers if desiring to be on campus during the Camp. They are subject to the normal rules for campers.
    - iii. Ministers' children who are over the designated camp age are not permitted to visit with or without their parents.
- 4. In order to further ensure the security of the campus, all persons staying in the RV Association Park desiring to enter the Camp must enter and exit with appropriate ID through the Camp Main Entrance or the Security Gate at the Footbridge Entrance when Security personnel are present.
