

# Texas District Crusader, Junior High and Senior High Camp Camper Policy

## ELIGIBILITY

- CRUSADER CAMP: Ages 8-11 within the current calendar year
- JUNIOR HIGH CAMP: Ages 12-14 within the current calendar year
- SENIOR HIGH CAMP: Ages 15-20 within the current calendar year
- Must have completed Camper's Application (including Medical Consent and ALL Signatures) on file with Camp Office with completed payment
- If requesting to stay in a RV, Camper must be son/daughter/grandson/granddaughter of RV Dean/Matron

## GENERAL GUIDELINES

- All Campers are expected to abide by all Camp Policies and Procedures at all times
- All Campers must wear Camp ID Armband at all times
- All Campers are required to attend all scheduled Camp activities unless permitted to do otherwise by Executive Staff
- All electronic entertainment/media devices are prohibited; these items will be confiscated and held in owner's name at the Camp Office until Camper checks out
- Cell phones are allowed for communication purposes only
- All photography and/or videography is strictly prohibited in all dorms, RVs and restrooms at all times
- All Campers are not allowed to leave the Campus at any time without consent from the Executive Staff
- All Campers checking out of Camp must leave the Camp Ground within 30 minutes of final checkout and cannot return once they have left the grounds

## DRESS CODE

- Gentlemen
  - Hair must be off the ears and off the collar
  - No mustaches, beards, or long sideburns
  - No short pants/shorts
  - No extremely short-sleeved shirts or tank tops
  - No other immodest apparel
  - No jewelry
- Ladies
  - Skirts must come below the knee
  - No skirt slits that come above the knee
  - No shorts, pants, culottes, walking shorts, or gauchos
  - No leggings that show below the skirt
  - No extremely short sleeves, capped sleeves, or tank tops
  - No other immodest apparel
  - No makeup
  - No jewelry

## PROBATION OR DISMISSAL FROM CAMP

Violations warranting probation or dismissal include, but are not limited to:

- Any student conducting themselves in such a manner as to bring reproach upon the Texas District UPC Camp endeavor
- Possessing, selling or using illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages and/or tobacco
- Sexual promiscuity or misconduct
- Possession of firearms, knives, tasers, pepper spray and/or other weapons
- Possession of pornography in any form
- Fighting
- Leaving the dorm after curfew without permission
- Absolute defiance of authority
