

# Suggested Crusader Camper Packing List

Please properly label all items with Camper's Name

Note: All services are casual; therefore, most Campers choose to dress for the day in casual clothes and remain in the same clothes for the duration of the day. Extra clothes may be needed in case of bad weather, and they are allowed to change into "play" clothes before recreation time.

Clothes (at least four complete changes)

Under clothes

Sleepwear

Socks

Shoes

Bedding for a twin bed or sleeping bag and pillow

Towels/Washcloths

Soap

Deodorant

Shampoo/Conditioner/Hair Dryer

Brush/Comb

Hairspray/Gel/Hair Products

Toothbrush/Toothpaste

Glasses/Contacts with case and solution

Medications in the **original bottle** with label (to be given to Camp Nurse at Orientation)

Bible

Hat

Sunglasses

Sunscreen

Umbrella/Raincoat

Dirty Clothes Bag (separate bags are suggested for dry clothes and wet clothes/towels)

Ball glove if applicable

Water gun for Thursday's Water Day (to be used only in designated "Water Area")

Money for Concession Stand and Gift Shop (three daily meals are provided with registration; however, campers may want to purchase snacks and drinks in between meals. Complimentary cups of water are provided on a roving golf cart through the heat of the day. There is also a Gift Shop that sells small gifts and souvenirs)

Snacks/Drinks for in the dorm if wanted; however, campers do not have unlimited access to dorm during the day

Notebook to write names and addresses of new friends

Card games/board games to play in the dorms
